

- ❖ **Situation :** In the U.K.G. class, one child did not follow discipline. He often created disturbance, fought with friends, and disobeyed the teacher's instructions. As a result, his concentration in studies was very low.
- ❖ **Efforts Taken :** Talked to the child lovingly to understand his problem. Regularly explained classroom rules and used small examples to show the importance of discipline. Maintained constant communication between teacher, child, and parents. Praised and encouraged the child for good behavior. Used games, group activities, and stories to build discipline habits.
- ❖ **Results :** Based on the questionnaire, it was found that most parents are satisfied with teachers giving personal attention to their children. Around 60% of parents believed that teachers give sufficient personal attention, 30% said attention is moderate, and 10% said very little attention is given. No parents chose the "no" option. Many parents gave positive feedback, appreciating the teachers' efforts toward students' learning, behavior, and overall development.

Most parents expect teachers to teach with love, patience, and discipline, and schools to give importance to both academics and extracurricular activities.

- ❖ **Conclusion :** This research shows that parents mainly expect schools and teachers to focus on the overall development of children. Most parents are happy with teachers' work but want more focus on discipline and activities. Teachers, parents, and schools must work together like a team.
