

**Problem area :** Study of the Reasons and Solutions why students of Std. 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> do not pay much attention of English Subject at Narayan Vidyalaya, Bharuch.

**Possible Causes related to the problem :** During the Teaching –Learning process in the English Subject. It was found that some of the following possible reasons are responsible for the difficulties students face in understanding. Along with these reasons, Clarity has also been provided regarding the assumptions and facts.

1. Students may like and dislike the English subject and studying English.
2. Students may find English Difficult to learn and speak.
3. The teacher may not have explained it properly and interestingly to the students.
4. Students are not mentally prepared for the English learning.
5. The students were absent when topic explained.
6. The students have paid much attention to other activities.
7. The teacher did not teach the students with educational equipments or models.

3. Study of the Reasons and Solutions why students of Std. 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> do not pay much attention of English Subject bases of the achieved scores of pre-test and post-test only. The opinions of the students were taken on the opinionnaire and Open- ended questions.


**Research Evaluation :** The mean of pre-test and Post-test scores of the selected group was calculated.
